New York City High School Artist-in-Residence Programs	Target Audience
<p>Experienced professional conductors, singers and pianists from the National Chorale serve as Artists-in-Residence in New York high schools, working weekly throughout the school year to develop vocal programs, choruses, and school musicals.</p> <p>Chorale Artists-in-Residence work with a school's administrators and music faculty to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create and/or strengthen existing high school choral, vocal and music theatre programs • Introduce students to choral music, music theatre, opera; music in different styles and from different nations; and illustrate the broad range of individual and group vocal skills which can be achieved • Nurture the development of each student's individual musical talents • Teach by example, demonstrating essential vocal skills: breath support, singing technique, pitch, rhythm, tuning, blend, diction, phrasing, style and interpretation, while music is in rehearsal • Develop students' personal and academic discipline through improving musical skills and teaching how to work with other students in goal-oriented performing groups • Provide professional vocal instruction during student rehearsal activities and in group voice classes • Provide sight reading instruction, teaching students to read music as one learns to read a language • Provide choral and music theatre performances for the student body and the school community • Use vocal music as a teaching tool for broad cross-curricular learning • Bring together, through singing, young people of different ages and experience levels; and use singing as a means of integrating newly-arrived students into the school community • Provide Professional Staff Development, if needed, with one-to-one mentoring for music teachers to help them improve their vocal, musical, and conducting skills. 	<p>Students in choral and vocal programs General high school student body Choral and Music Theatre program conductors</p>
