Through active participation in group music-making experiences and discussions, course participants gain an understanding of the musical development of children from infancy through age six, while developing their own innate musicality. Over the course of the semester, participants develop their ability to facilitate, lead, and assess engaging music experiences in their early childhood program. Additionally, participants learn to play selections on the recorder and are introduced to music notation. Previous music training is not needed. Tuition-free registration is available for early childhood professionals who are employed by publicly funded schools, day care centers, preschools, PreK centers, or social service agencies.
