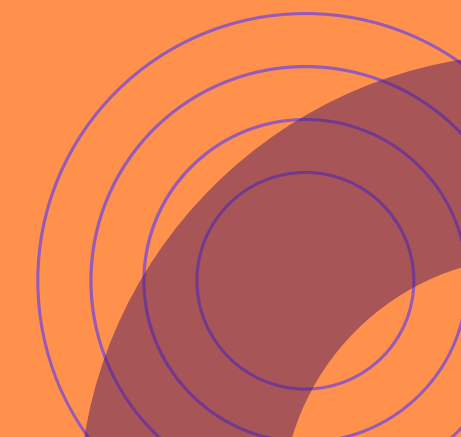


Notes in Motion

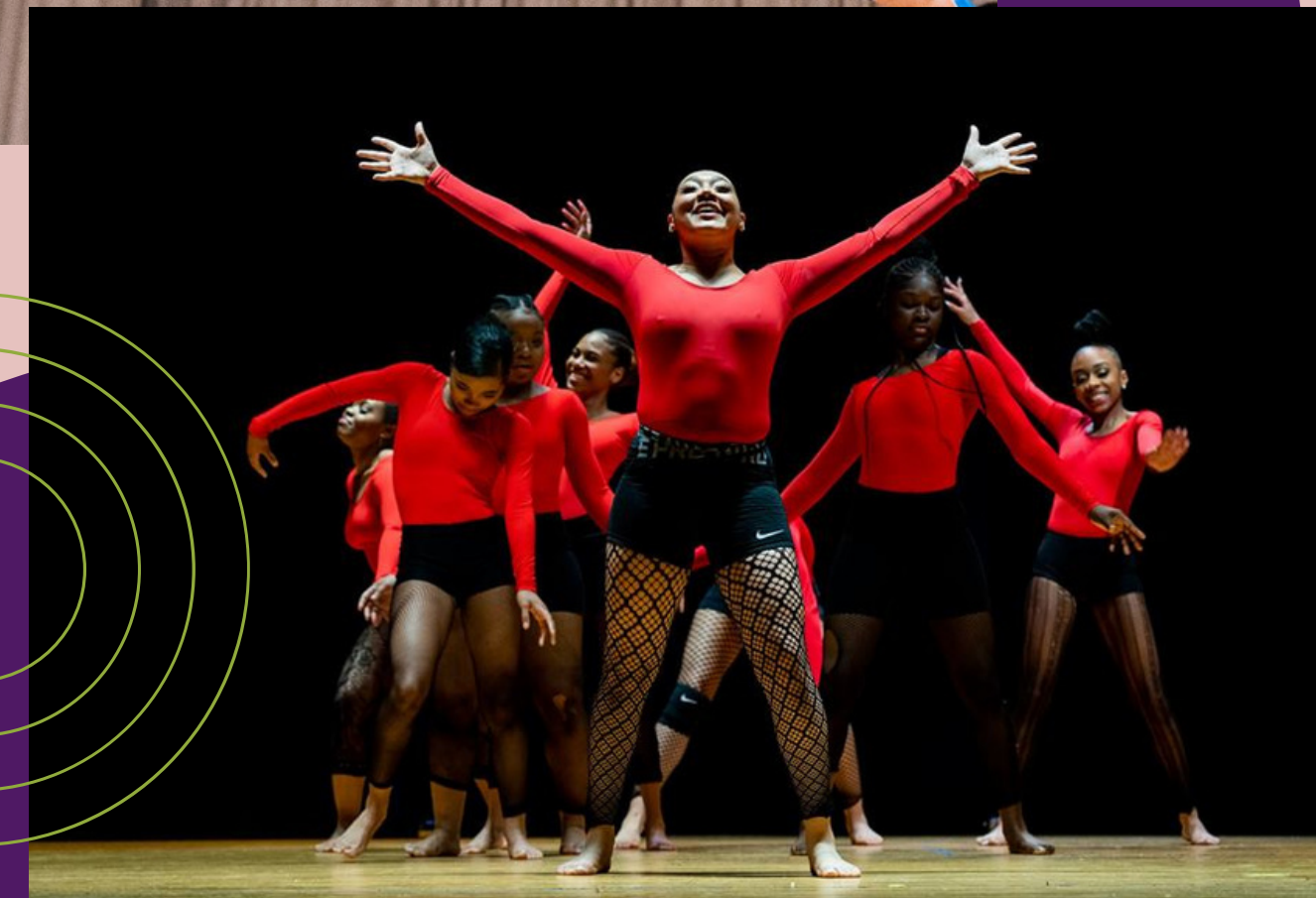
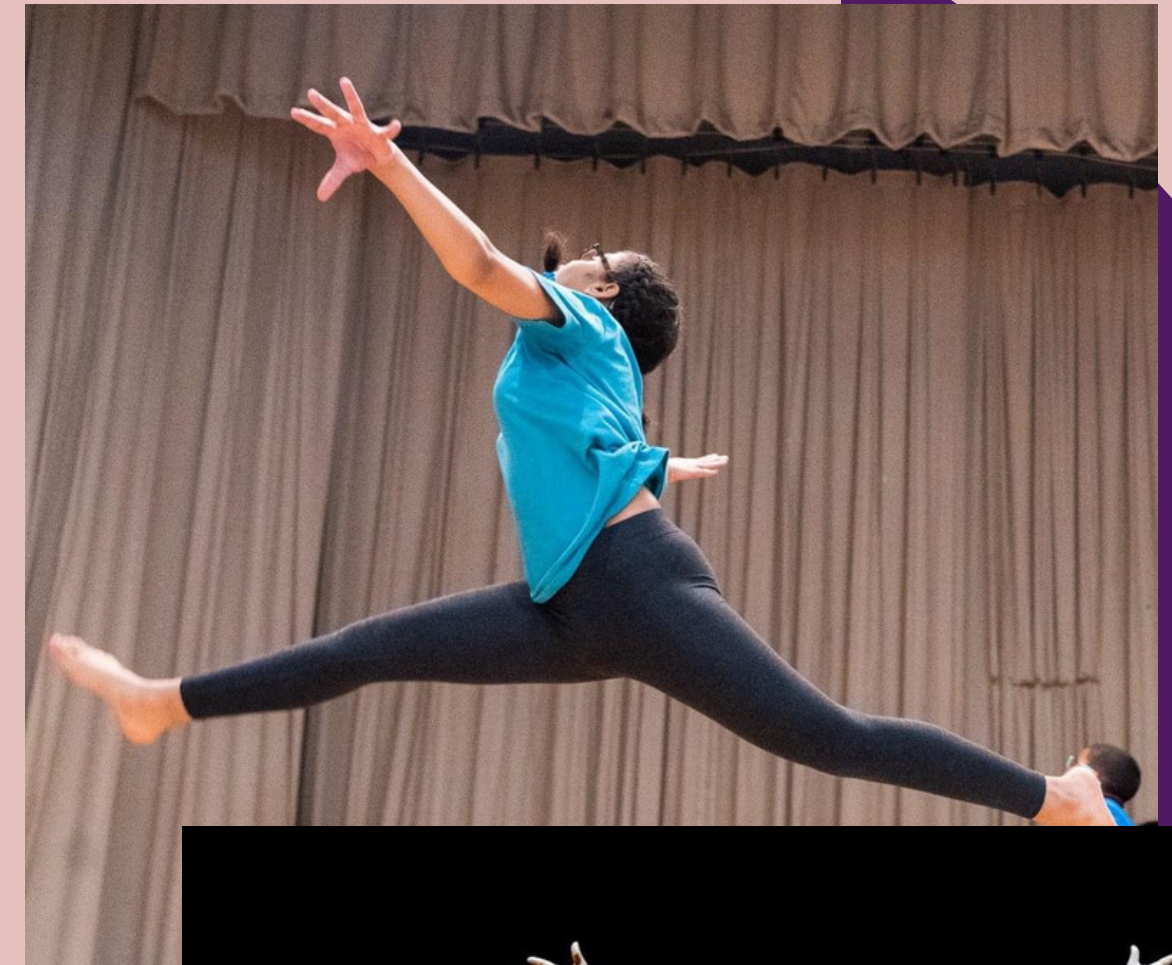

- Community/Family Programs | Modern Dance Performances by Amanda Selwyn Dance Theatre



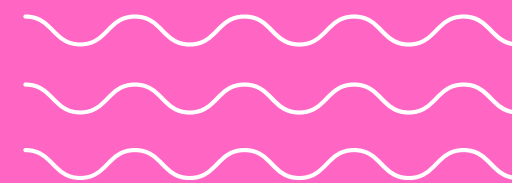

- Detailed lesson plans and follow-up activities



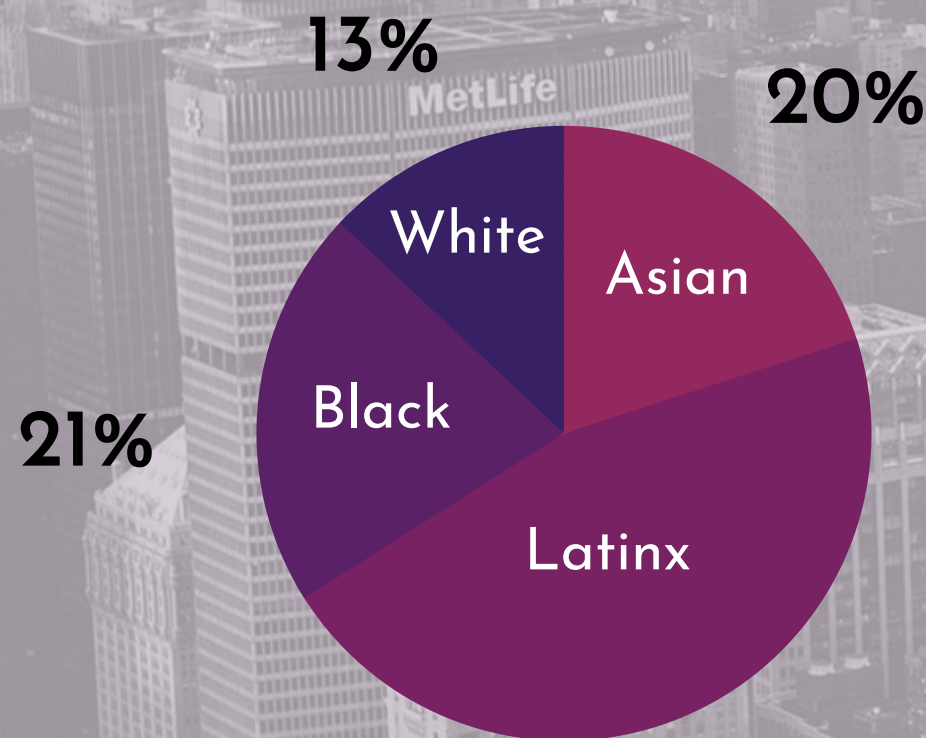

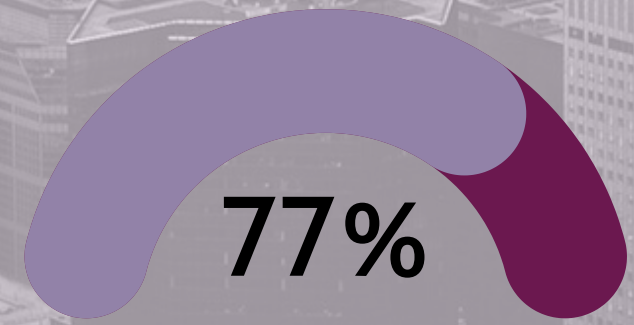
