ARTIST RESIDENCIES IN THE CLASSROOM

Through this unique program, a teaching artist will join your school for eight weeks or longer to provide instruction in visual arts, dance, music, or drama. We can align our program to classroom curriculum in all subjects. Each residency ends in a culminating exhibition or performance.



SPECIAL EDUCATION ARTS PROGRAMS

Our teaching artists are experts in their fields in the visual arts, dance, music and drama, and are highly experienced working with students of all abilities. Most workshops are multisensory, and can include reading readiness or math readiness through the arts.



YOUTH LEADERSHIP AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION WORKSHOPS

Two teaching artists/facilitators work with up to 32 students. Four hour-long sessions are offered over four weeks. Using roleplay, improvisation, and other theater techniques, the workshops address challenging topics, such as peer pressure and drug use. The program is for high school students but may be adapted for middle school students.
