Marquis Studios' Overview:

Founded In 1977, Marquis Studios provides a full spectrum of arts experiences in over 140 schools in all 5 boroughs of NYC. Marquis Studios directly serves 25,000 children each year. These programs are designed to integrate arts activities and social emotional learning with instruction in academic core subjects by aligning with state and city standards. Our planning process is individualized for each residency with the Teaching Artists and classroom teachers meeting to discuss the educational goals before developing the curriculum. Not just a one-time program, Marquis Studios involves the entire school community through professional development for school staff and family workshops to create sustainable arts integration.



Marquis Studios' Overview:

Marquis Studios has a strong partnership with District 75 schools and our teaching artists are experienced working in inclusive classrooms with a diverse population of learners and languages.

Marquis Studios offers an annual “Teaching Artist Training Institute” at PS 37 in Staten Island, which is a 6 week program with a 20 person cohort of teaching artists, teachers, and school administrators training participants in best practices for teaching the arts with neurodiverse learners



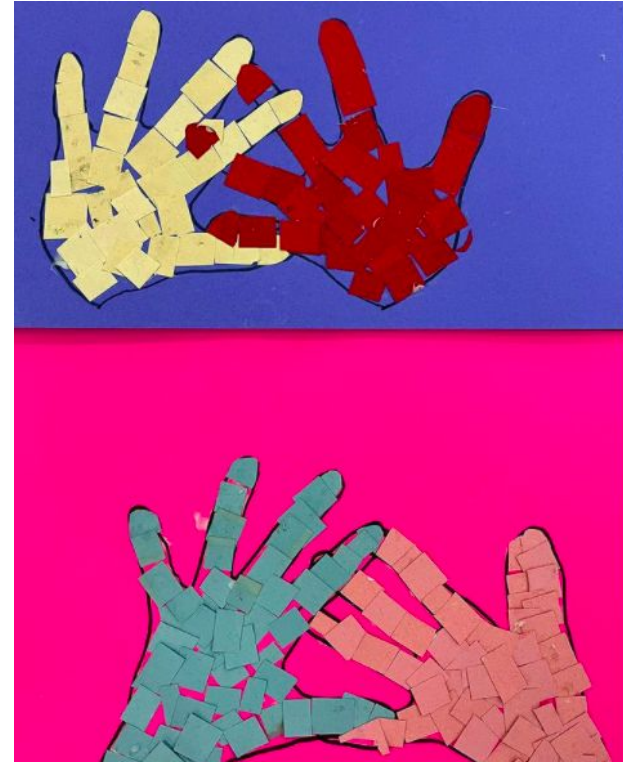


Marquis Studios' Team:

20+ Teaching Assistants: paid to assist with after-school programs; interested in teaching artistry as a career





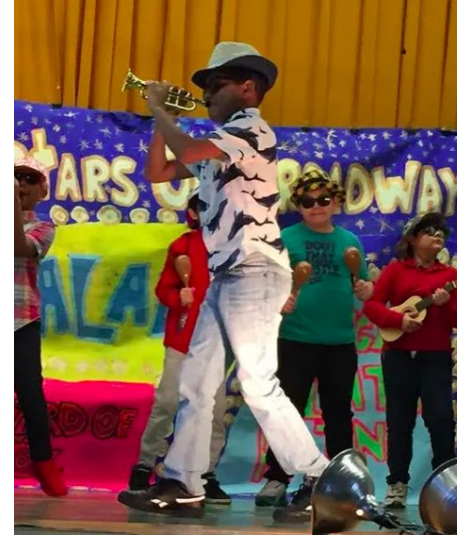
